

The Kalamazoo Township Clerk's Office maintains a **Permanent Absent Voter List**. The Permanent Absent Voter List is a list of voters who qualify under state law to vote by absentee ballot. Voters on this list will automatically receive an **application** for all elections held in the Township of Kalamazoo. Voters must complete, sign, and return the application for **every** election in order for the absent voter ballot to be sent.

If you meet **one** of the following requirements, you may vote absentee:

- Age 60 years old or older
- Unable to vote without assistance at the polls
- Expecting to be out of town on election day
- In jail awaiting arraignment or trial
- Unable to attend the polls due to religious reasons
- Appointed to work as an election inspector in a precinct outside of your precinct of residence
