LIFTING OF THE PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER ADVISORY Water Infrastructure Repair South Clarendon Street, Kalamazoo Township

March 22, 2019, Kalamazoo, MI – As of Friday, March 22, 2019, at 3:00 p.m., the precautionary boil water advisory issued March 20, 2019 has been lifted by the City of Kalamazoo, in cooperation with the Kalamazoo County Health and Community Services Department. Citizens in the affected area can now use City water for consumption as well as all other purposes. Bacteriological sampling within the affected area verified that the water is safe to drink. The affected area is as follows:

South Clarendon Street – From Grove Street (northern boundary) to Academy Street (southern boundary), both sides of the street. Does not include the southwest corner of South Clarendon Street and Grove Street.

North Clarendon Street – Only the northeast corner of corner of North Clarendon Street and Grove Street.

South Berkley Street – Only the northeast corner of corner of South Berkley Street and Academy Street.

South Arlington Street – From Grove Street (northern boundary) to Academy Street (southern boundary), both sides of the street.

Academy Street – From South Dartmouth Street (western boundary) to South Arlington Street (eastern boundary), both sides of the street.
